USMLE STEP 1

One of the most challenging steps in the process to obtain a medical license in the United States of America is the USMLE STEP 1 exam required by the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Students (ECFMG).

NUEVA ENTIDAD PREPARA A ESTUDIANTES DE MEDICINA Y MÉDICOS PARA PASAR EL EXAMEN USMLE



Santo Domingo.- Para ejercer la medicina en los Estados Unidos los médicos deben rendir el examen de licencia llamado USMLE (United States Medical Licensing Exam), que consta de tres pasos. Este requisito es vital sin importar donde se gradúe el médico.

Para obtener la licencia de médicos en Estados Unidos hay que prepararse muy bien.

El paso uno del USMLE es el requisito más difícil para conseguir la licencia, porque es volver a lo básico y el
